Days of attendance are consistent, are non-transferable nor credited to another day.

Paid Closure Days are required if they fall on your regularly scheduled day: Days for the 2026–2027 school year

General Information:

General daily program as outlined run from 7am-5:30pm. Extended flexibility for early drop off at 6:30am or later pick up outside of your contract till 5:30pm.

Enrollment includes permission for daily school age bussing to their public school and walk to the fire company playground for afterschool play at times. Any specific themes field trip will have its own permission form.

Tuition is 3 or 5 days for the wellness of the community social group

Weekly program fees include AM/PM Snack and Lunch when here a full day

Additional Fees will include full day of care \$10 additional to weekly tuition, optional field trips, \$40 bounced check fee, extended care hours, tuition late fee, attendance late fee

Tuition is DUE Thursday prior to the week of service

All forms and payments must be provided prior to attendance

I understand that pick up time from care is as listed on my registration, and IF I DO NOT PICK UP my child by the agreed time, and staff need to remain on site to baby-sit your youngster, that the baby-sitting charges will be in effect: \$20 for the first 15 minutes late, and \$5 for every 5 minute block after that time.

Group Recreation and Care:

I understand that being prepared to participate in Community/Environmental program infers that my child is self sufficient in all personal care needs, including the ability to walk and move freely, feed self, toilet self, and demonstrates adequate self regulation.

I understand that my youngster will be required to facilitate the day with supervision from BAYR Staff within state regulation ratio and be among other persons in their group through the day- and self regulate themselves within reason.

I understand that within the BAYR community we do not tolerate bullying of others, foul language, destruction of property, disrespect of staff, disrespect of peers self or property, violent or aggressive behavior to anyone- and that if my youngster displays severe behavior that he/she will be dismissed from the program without a refund.

Arrival and Departure:

General daily programs as outlined run from 7am-5:30pm. Extended flexibility for early drop off at 6:30am is available.

I understand that the arrival time into day camp is at the time I have listed on my registration.

I understand that pick up time from care is as listed on my registration, and IF I DO NOT PICK UP my camper by the agreed time, and staff need to remain on site to baby-sit your youngster, that the baby-sitting charges will be in effect: \$20 for the first 15 minutes late, and \$5 for every 5 minute block after that time.

I understand that I will walk my child to the door, and not let them run in the parking lot, sign them in/out and communicate any daily needs with the receiving staff.

Be Prepared for the Day:

*Wear clothes acceptable for daily activities and care

*Bring a water bottle daily

*We provide lunch for full days of care unless on a field trip, you may need to pack a lunch appropriate for travel in nature

*Bring a backpack daily for your child's belongings, especially something sturdy for when on field trips (not a plastic bag)

*If your child needs a change of clothes if they get dirty, please provide that in their bag or cubby

Meals and Snacks:

*Weekly program fees include AM/PM Snack and Lunch when here for a full day of care, or not out on an excursion

*Camp participants are offered USDA approved snacks & lunch included, unless the camper is on a field trip when a packed lunch from home will be needed

Medications:

*Medications coming to the program: MUST be in the original container with a signed note from parent/physician with instructions.

Additional Information:

A monthly calendar will be provided for paid closures, optional school days off and other activities and themes to support the educational process.

No extra electronics, toys ect. We are not responsible for lost or broken toys/items.

DO NOT bring Toys or Electronics from Home

Please make sure everything is labeled in a sturdy travel bag for adventures, no plastic grocery bags that will rip

*I understand that choosing to participate in a Community/Environmental program is choosing to have an experience in a social environment, free of technologies such as cell phones/computers/tablets ect. Any such technologies are not needed and should be left at home. If a child or child's parents decide to send such devices to the program, it is understood that BAYR is not responsible for loss or damage to such items. And I further understand that if BAYR staff determines that usage of such device by my child is disruptive or inappropriate, that BAYR staff has my permission to confiscate such devices, and will be available upon pick up- and that device may not return to the program environment.

- Cell Phone/Tablet Use Policy for minors in the BAYR Program
 - First preference is that phones/tablets are NOT brought to the program-there is no use for phones as the Staff will make communications to parents at any necessary time, and the program has tablets in-house youth participants can use. However, in this current culture, it seems that phones/tablets are an evident part of youth culture to use in everyday life.
 - IF a minor brings a tablet/phone/device to the program:
 - It is understood that such devices may only be used at approved/appropriate times- that when the content of the program is actively occurring, said devices are to be put away
 - It is understood that the content of material that is being viewed or discussed/chatted is appropriate for minors to be engaged upon

- It is understood that devices may Not be given/shared to another minor- minors need parent permission to be on devices, it cannot be at the discretion of another minor to hand over a device
- It is understood that if a device enters the program, it is by parent permission to do so- BAYR is in NO manner responsible for devices lost/stolen/broken
- It is understood that minors are strictly FORBIDDEN to Photograph, video or record any other minor or person within the program. BAYR administration needs to receive parental permission to photograph youth participants. The minor with a device has no such permission from another parent to record, video their child
- It is understood that if a minor with a device is found to have infringed any of the above polices to have the privilege of bringing a phone/devices to BAYR programs, that- that device will be taken from the minor and held until parent pick up. A conference will be held to discuss if the phone privilege will be returned.
- I give permission for my child to me be included in photographs that may be used for projects and BAYR media.
